

Torre Camigliati

Camigliatello Silano *Parco Old Calabria* (0984 578 200/www.torrecamigliati.it/www.oldcalabria.org). €€.

Set in the heart of the Sila Grande, Torre Camigliati is a listed 18th-century baronial hunting lodge. It has recently been transformed into a cultural centre devoted to local arts and crafts, with a literary dimension inspired by the writings of 'grand tour' travellers to the region, especially Norman Douglas, author of the 1915 travelogue, *Old Calabria*. Surrounded by a 200 acre private estate, it's a tranquil place. The 12 main rooms have been kitted out in period style (iron beds, antique wardrobes), and some nearby workers' cottages have also been converted into swish apartments. Guided (and non guided) historical and literary walks and excursions to nearby places of interest are gladly arranged.
